

AROUND THE SQUARE

This block is a Pineapple version of the Log Cabin block and is very striking when you add bold colors to it. We have provided the center block, which is a blue plaid cut at 6 inches squared. In addition, you will need a dark solid color of your choice (or should read as solid) and a variety of eight 2 inch strips of your choosing. We have chosen to go with small medium to dark prints. The block should measure 14 inches.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut the blue into 4 inch strips at WOF. You will need 12 four (4) inch squares.
2. Starting with the center plaid, sew one 2 inch strip to the bottom and the top of the block. Then repeat for the sides.
3. Take 4 of the black squares, iron, fold in half, making sure the corners are even. Sew on and then trim the excess triangles off. Press.
4. Repeat the process twice and you are finished.

This is how the block should look:
